Dry stone walling 22 and 23 September 10am - 4pm Outwoods, Loughborough £70 per person; £60*

An introduction to this ancient craft. Attendees will learn how to recognise the different types of stone and their role within the building process of the wall. Taking this forward we will strip down and repair a section of tumbledown wall rebuilding it back to its original state, using the different types of stone already identified and available to us.

Hedgelaying for beginners

A course tailored for beginners, if you have ever fancied learning about the art and practicing the traditional skills of laying a hedge then please come along and give it a go. We will go through the various processes of hedgelaying allowing plenty of time for you to lay a section of hedge, stake and bind it. There will be ample opportunity to use the traditional hand tools suitable for this work.
